They engage with parents and stakeholders and organize community activations to highlight the importance of reading. They also observe, report on and capture data re activities taking place at the schools and communities.

Can you be a Story Sparker?

To be a Story Sparker you must be fluent in **Setswana, Afrikaans and English** have a **Matric certificate**, be computer literate, and be able to demonstrate previous work experience with strong administration skills. Most importantly, you must be passionate about growing the love of reading in your community, be interested in children, and able to engage with children and teachers. You also need to live within walking distance from one of the local Early Childhood Development (ECD) centers.

Role and responsibilities:

Conduct home visits to support parents with programme content, support parent and community training workshops, assist with community mapping and participant recruitment, support activations in the community to raise awareness about reading, distribute reading materials to parents and ECD centres, act as a brand ambassador and promote the project in the community and report on key activities.
