Job Overview

Nal'ibali (isiXhosa for "here's the story") is dedicated to fostering a culture of reading among children from birth to 12 years of age across South Africa by creating and sharing engaging reading content in all South African languages.

This for the USAID-funded programme in the uMgungundlovu District of KZN, aimed at improving early learning outcomes and enhancing school readiness for children within the local communities. This initiative focuses on empowering families, early childhood educators, and other community members involved in the care and development of young children.

Can you be a Story Sparker?

To be a Story Sparker, you must be fluent in **English and isiZulu**, have a **Matric certificate**, be computer literate, and demonstrate previous work experience with strong administration skills. Most importantly, you must be enthusiastic about growing the love of reading in your community, interested in children, and able to engage with children and teachers.

Roles and Responsibilities

Conduct home visits to support parents with programme content, support parent and community training workshops, assist with community mapping and participant recruitment, support activations in the community to raise awareness about reading, distribute reading materials to parents and ECD centres, act as a brand ambassador and promote the project in the community and report on key activities.
