When last did you read a good book just to get lost in another world and stay there for some time learning new words or new ways of using words and simply savouring each moment? As a publisher and a book lover, I hate finishing a good book as it means having to find a new one – something which isn't always that easy!

I grew up around books. In my childhood, every household owned a Dover stove. In a typical scene, Mother would be making supper and the whole family would be gathered in the candle-lit kitchen listening to the radio or to our parents telling stories. We didn't worry about data or load shedding! It was this family time that bonded us as a family and instilled my love of words and stories.

I still share books with my sister and brothers today. When we meet, we speak about the books we've read and what we've learnt from them. It's a real book club moment when we realise that we have all learnt and experienced something different but equally valuable from a book.

It's important to me that we grow a nation of strong and powerful readers. But how do we change the phrase "black Africans don't read"? We have good books about South Africa written by black South Africans. Books that are illustrated and have great story lines about our country. This is how we share our cultures and tell our stories. Let's discover the treasures and knowledge which are hidden inside books so that we can share this with future generations.

Storytelling has been around for so many years; let's preserve that. Let's find time to read to our children and teach them how to read and write in their mother tongues. Let's build a culture of reading and sharing words and story worlds. Great leaders write and read books. What kind of leader are you? What kind of leader do you want your children to be?

Wagcina nini ukufunda incwadi emnandi ukuze ujule komunye umhlaba bese uhlala lapho isikhathi esithile ukuze ufunde amagama amasha noma izindlela ezintsha zokusebenzisa amagama noma ukuthokozela isikhathi ngasinye nje? Njengomshicileli kanye nomthandi wezincwadi, ngiyakuzonda ukuqeda ukufunda incwadi emnandi ngoba lokho kuchaza ukuthi kumele ngiyothola entsha – okuyinto engahlali ilula kangako!

Ngakhula ngizungezwe yizincwadi. Ngesikhathi sami sobungane, yonke imizi yayinesitofu se-Dover. Esizindeneni esijwayelekile, uMama ubezobe enza isidlo sakusihlwa bese umndeni wonke uhlale ekhishini elikhanyiswe ngekhandlela ulalele umsakazo noma abazali bethu bexoxa izindaba. Sasingakhathazekile nge-data noma ukucishwa kukagesi (load shedding) ngezikhathi ezithile. Kwakuyilesi sikhathi somndeni esasisenza sibumbane njengomndeni futhi nesagxilisa uthando lwami lwamagama kanye nezindaba.

Ngisabelana ngezincwadi nodadewethu nabafowethu nanamhlanje. Uma sihlalana, sikhuluma ngezincwadi esizifundile kanye nokuthi sifundeni kuzona. Kuba yisikhathi sethimba lokufunda sangempela uma sesithola ukuthi sonke sifunde futhi saphinde sehllelwa okwehlukile kodwa okuyigugu ngendlela efanayo encwadini.

Kubalulekile kimi ukuthi sithuthukise izizwe sabafundi abaqinile futhi abanamandla. Sisishintsha kanjani isisho esithi "abamnyama base-Afrika abafundi"? Sinezincwadi ezinhle ezimayelana neNingizimu Afrika ezibhalwe ngabantu abamnyama baseNingizimu Afrika. Izincwadi ezinemifanekiso zixoxa indaba emnandi ngezwe lethu. Sabelana kanje ngamasiko ethu, sixoxe izindaba zethu. Ake sithole ingcebo kanye nolwazi olufihleke ngaphakathi kwezincwadi ukuze sabelane ngalokhu nezizukulwane zakusasa.

Ukuxoxa izindaba sekube khona iminyaka eminingi kakhulu, ake sikugcine lokhu. Ake sithole isikhathi sokufundela izingane zethu nokuthi sizifundise ukuthi kufundwa bese kubhalwa kanjani ngezilimi zazo zasekhaya. Ake sakhe usiko lokufunda kanye nokwabelana ngemihlaba yezindaba. Abaholi abakhulu babhala baphinde bafunde izincwadi. Ungumholi onjani wena? Ngabe ufuna ukuthi izingane zakho zibe ngabaholi abanjani?

Books in a flash!

Book Dash gets together volunteer professionals to create new, African storybooks that anyone can freely translate and distribute. Since they started in 2014, they've produced 52 new books, many of which have appeared in the Nal'ibali newspaper supplement. We spoke to this group of inspiring and passionate South Africans to find out more about the work they do.

How does Book Dash make books?

We hold book creation events where we get fifty volunteers – writers, illustrators, designers and editors – together in one place. They work for over twelve hours straight in small teams to produce new children's storybooks.

Where do you find these volunteers?

We call for applications before a Book Dash event and then we select people we think are best suited to the task! For each event, we look for great talent and a range of languages, backgrounds, ages and genders. We choose experienced professionals that are very good at what they do because we have to produce good books so quickly.

Why do you do this?

We believe that all children should own a hundred books by the time they are five years old.

How do you help to make this happen?

The books we produce can be downloaded for free from our website (www.bookdash.org). We also fundraise so that we can give away printed copies of our books. So far, we have managed to give away 55 000 books.

Why do you think stories are important for children?

Stories help us make sense of the world, which makes us happier people. There's also loads of science showing that children's brains develop better – especially in the first one thousand days of life – if they have lots of books.

What kinds of books does Book Dash create?

We don't set out to make books that teach children a lesson. We want to create books that children will just enjoy, because that's how you encourage them to read – and actually, children learn best when they're enjoying something.

What are some of your favourite children's books?

I want my hat back by Jon Klaasen and any books by Julia Donaldson and Dr Seuss.

Izincwadi ezikhiqizwa ngokushesha!

IBook Dash ihlanganisa ndawonye abaqeqeshelwe umsebenzi othile abangamavolontiya ukuze benze izincwadi zezindaba zase-Afrika ezintsha, wonke umuntu okhululekile ukuthi azihumushe bese ezisabalalisa. Kusakela mhla beqala ngowezi-2014, sebekhiqize izincwadi ezintsha ezingama-52, eziningi zazo sezivele esithasiselweni sephephandaba sakwaNal'ibali. Sixoxe naleli thimba labantu baseNingizimu Afrika abafaka ugqozi nabanentshisekelo ukuze sithole kabanzi ngomsebenzi abawenzayo.

Ngabe uBook Dash uzenza kanjani izincwadi?

Siba nemicimbi yokwenza izincwadi lapho sihlanganisa khona amavolontiya angamashumi amahlanu – ababhali, abadwebi, amadizayina kanye nabahleli – babe ndawonye endaweni eyodwa. Basebenza amahora ayishumi nambili bengaphumuli ngamathimba amancane bese bekhiqiza izincwadi ezintsha zezindaba zezingane.

Ngabe niwathola kuphi lawa mavolontiya?

Simema abantu ukuthi bafake izicelo ngaphambi komcimbi weBook Dash bese sikhetha abantu esicabanga ukuthi bakufanele kangcono ukwenza umsebenzi! Emcimbini ngamunye, sibheka abanekhono elihle kanye nezinhlobo zezilimi, umlando, iminyaka kanye nobulili okwehlukene. Sikhetha abaqeqeshelwe ukwenza umsebenzi othile abanekhono abahle kakhulu kulokho abakwenzayo ngoba kumele sikhqize izincwadi ezisezingeni elifanele ngokushesha kangaka.

Nikwenzelani lokhu?

Sikholelwa ekutheni zonke izingane kumele zibe nezincwadi eziyikhulu ngesikhathi sezineminyaka emihlanu.

Ngabe nisiza kanjani ukwenza ukuthi lokhu kwenzekwe?

Izincwadi esizikhqizayo zingathwetshulwa ngokusebenzisa insiza yekhompuyutha mahhala kusizindalwazi sethu (www.bookdash.org). Senza nezinhlelo zokuqoqa izimali ukuze sikwazi ukunikela nangamakhophi aprintiwe ezincwadi zethu. Okwamanje, sesikwaze ukunikela ngezincwadi eziyizi-55 000.

Ngabe ucabanga ukuthi izindaba zibaluleke ngani ezinganeni?

Izindaba zisisiza ukuthi sikwazi ukwenza umqondo walokho okwenzeka emhlabeni, nokusenza sibe ngabantu abathokozile kunabanye. Kukhona nendathane yesayensi ekhombisa ukuthi imiqondo yezingane ithuthuka kangcono – ikakhulukazi ezinsukwini zokuqala zokuphila eziyinkulungwane – uma zinezincwadi eziningi.

Ngabe uBook Dash wenza izinhlobo zezincwadi ezinjani?

Asisuki nje sizimisele ukwenza izincwadi ezizofundisa izingane isifundo. Sifuna ukwenza izincwadi izingane ezizozithokozela, ngoba uzikhuthaza kanjalo ukuthi zifunde – kanti empeleni-ke, izingane zifunda kangcono uma zithokozela okuthile.

Ngabe yiziphi ezinye zezincwadi zezingane ozithandayo?

U-*I want my hat back* kaJon Klaasen kanye nanoma yiziphi izincwadi zikaJulia Donaldson kanye noDr Seuss.

Get story active!

Here are some ideas for using the two cut-out-and-keep books, *Stronger than Lion*, (pages 5, 6, 11 and 12) and *Is there anyone like me?* (pages 7, 8, 9 and 10), as well as the Story Corner story, *The best detective* (pages 13 and 15) – a story featuring the Nal'ibali characters. Choose the ideas that best suit your children's ages and interests.



Stronger than Lion

All the animals are worried about Lion's appetite – it is so big that soon he will have eaten all the animals! Together they try to think of a plan to change things, but aren't able to. Then, a little mouse comes up with a brave, two-week plan to keep them safe from Lion.



- ★ Discuss these questions with older children:
 - ☉ When someone is called "mighty" it means that they are powerful. Who do you think was the most powerful in the story: Lion or Mouse? (Don't forget to share the reasons for your opinion!)
 - ☉ What lesson/s do you think this story teaches?
- ★ Use cardboard or paper plates, paint and string to create masks for the characters in the story. Then act out the story wearing your masks.
- ★ Write a play using the text from the story – then perform it with friends!

Is there anyone like me?

This is a story about a young animal who searches for someone who is just like him, but then finds out that he is unique. It's a sweet and simple story that celebrates how each of us is unique.



- ★ As you read the book together, talk about the different animals and what they are doing in the pictures.
- ★ Look at the picture on the cover with your children and talk about how we can see our reflections in water and in mirrors too. Let your children look at themselves carefully in the mirror and have fun pretending to describe themselves to someone who has never seen them before.
- ★ Encourage your children to draw pictures of themselves and then to include the words on page 14 of the story with their pictures.

The best detective

Oh no! Bella can't find Noodle anywhere! Bella's friends help her to look for him and land up getting a big surprise – Noodle and his friend, Trixie, and three new puppies!




- ★ Maybe Bella should have made a "Lost" poster so that if someone found Noodle they would know who to return him to! Create this "Lost" poster on a piece of paper. Remember to include a picture of Noodle and a phone number for Bella's mother, as well as anything else you think would be important for someone to know.
- ★ Think of names for Noodle and Trixie's puppies. Then draw a picture of each one and write its name under its picture.

Yenza indaba ihlabe umxhwele!

Nanka amanye amacebo okusebenzisa izincwadi ezimbili ozozisika uzikhiphe, *Amandla adlula aweBhubesi*, (ikhasi 5, 6, 11 no-12) kanye nethi *Ingabe ukhona onjengam?* (ikhasi 7, 8, 9 kanye nele-10), kanye nendaba yeKhona Lezindaba, *Umseshi ohamba phambili* (amakhasi e-14 kanye nele-15) – indaba enabalingiswa bakwaNal'ibali. Khetha amacebo ahambisana kangcono neminyaka kanye nalokho okuthandwa yizingane zakho.

Amandla adlula aweBhubesi

Zonke izilwane zikhathazekile ngendlela uBhubesi akuthanda ngayo ukudla – ukuthanda kakhulu kangokuthi maduze nje uzobe esedle zonke izilwane! Zindawonye zizama ukuqhamuka nesu lokuguqula izinto, kodwa azikwazi ukwenza lokho. Bese, igundane elincane liqhamuka necebo elidinga ube nesibindi, elithatha amasonto amabili ukuze zizigcine ziphephile kuBhubesi.

- ★ Xoxani ngale mibuzo nezingane ezindadlana:
 - ☉ Uma umuntu kuthiwa "mkhulu" lokhu kuchaza ukuthi unamandla. Ngabe ucabanga ukuthi ubani obenamandla kakhulu endabeni: uBhubesi noma uGundane? (Ungakhohlwa ukwabelana nabanye ngezizathu zombono wakho!)
 - ☉ Ngabe yisiphi isifundo/yiziphi izifundo ocabanga ukuthi sifundiswa/zifundiswa yile ndaba?
- ★ Sebenzisani amapuleti ekhadibhodi noma ephepha, upende kanye nentambo ukuze nakhe amamaski abalingiswa abasendabeni. Bese nilingisa indaba nifake amamaski enu.
- ★ Bhala umdlalo usebenzisa umbhalo osendabeni – bese ulingisa lokhu nabangani!

Ingabe ukhona onjengami?

Le yindaba yesilwane esincane esifuna ofana naso, kodwa-ke sibe sesithola ukuthi sona sehlukile. Yindaba emnandi futhi elula egubha indlela omunye nomunye kithina ahlukile ngayo kwabanye.

- ★ Ngesikhathi nifunda incwadi ndawonye, xoxani ngezilwane ezahlukene kanye nalokho ezikwenzayo ezithombeni.
- ★ Bheka isithombe esisekhaveni nezingane zakho bese nixoxa ngokuthi singayibona kanjani indlela esibukeka ngayo emanzini kanye nasezibukweni. Vumela izingane zakho ukuthi zizibuke ngokucophelela esibukweni bese ziyazithokozisa ngokuzenza sengathi zizichazela umuntu ongakaze azibone phambilini.
- ★ Khuthaza izingane zakho ukuthi zidwebe izithombe zazo bese zifaka namagama asekhasini le-14 lendaba nezithombe zazo.

Umseshi ohamba phambili

Mamo! UBella akamtholi ndawo uNoodle! Abangani bakaBella bamsiza ukumfuna bagcine sebezithole phezu kokubamangaza kakhulu – uNoodle nomngani wakhe, uTrixie, kanye nemidlwane emithathu emisha!

- ★ Mhlawumbe uBella bekumele enze iphosta ethi: "Okulahlekile" ukuze uma kukhona othola uNoodle ezokwazi ukuthi umbuyisela kuphi! Yenza le phosta ethi: "Okulahlekile" epheshaneni. Khumbula ukufaka isithombe sikaNoodle kanye nenombolo yocingo kamama kaBella, kanye nanoma yini enye ocabanga ukuthi ingabaluleka ukuthi omunye umuntu ayazi.
- ★ Cabanga ngamagama emidlwane kaNoodle noTrixie. Bese udweba isithombe sawo ngamunye, ubhale igama lawo ngaphansi kwesithombe.

Ukuze uthole eminye imisebenzi yezindaba, yana ekhasini le-16.



“Perhaps,” thought Lion, “these silly fools want to crown me King. About time!”


At last, the day of the meeting dawned, and a bright and sunny day it was. Elephant declared the meeting open. The animals were all fuming.


UBhubesi waphendula amehlo akhe wawabhekisa ngapha nangapha. “Uphi pho?”

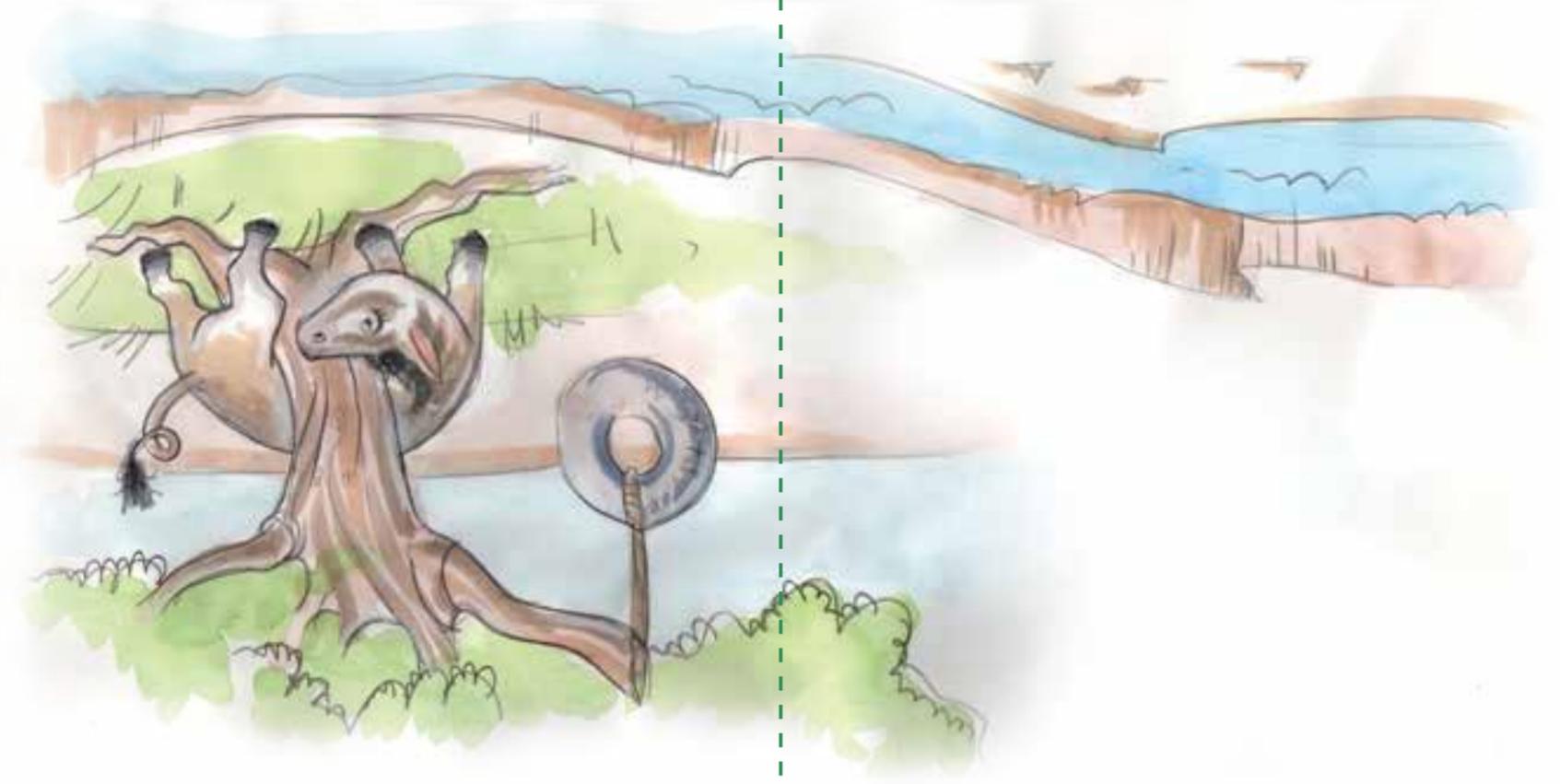




The best detective


